Please stand-by for the San Lorenzo Valley ARES Net. This is <<Callsign>> your Net Control Station for tonight. Tonight's net will be on <<repeater>>. Stations wishing to arrange a QSO on an alternate frequency please go ahead now.

<<Wait approximately one minute>>

Good evening. This is the San Lorenzo Valley Amateur Radio Service Net. This net meets each Tuesday, except Holidays, immediately after the county-wide net to further amateur radio emergency readiness, and to provide a common forum for interested amateurs throughout SLV. We invite ALL amateurs to participate in this net.

This is a DIRECTED net; please do not transmit until invited to do so by Net Control. This net may be interrupted at any time for Emergency or Priority traffic with a "double-break". This is <<Name>>, <<Callsign>>, Net Control.

<<drop repeater, switch to other repeater, announce net start on the repeater you're using>>

We will take check ins tonight alphabetically by call sign suffix. When checking in, please indicate if you have any traffic for the net. Please use standard phonetics when announcing your call sign.

Call signs with suffixes Alpha through Lima, please check in now.
<<pause, take check-ins, acknowledge checkins>>

Call signs with suffixes Mike through Zulu, please check in now.
<<pause, take check-ins, acknowledge checkins>>

<<if there are stations with traffic, return to each in turn.>>

Is there ANY other traffic or ANY late check-ins before we close the net?
<<long pause, then repeat question until no more responses>>

There is a total of <<number from above>> check-ins tonight.

This CONCLUDES the ARES NET. Your participation has contributed to our emergency communications readiness; thank you. The next meeting of this net will be next Tuesday after the county-wide net. The repeater is now released. This is net control <<Callsign>>.
